
Chemistry 11 Branching Rules

General steps to naming hydrocarbons:

- 1. Find and name parent chain
- 2. Number the parent chain, starting at the end closest to branches (lowest numbers possible)
- 3. Name each branch
- 4. Write the final name by naming the branches first and then naming the parent chain. Use commas between numbers and hyphens between branches

Rule 1: Order branches alphabetically



Rule 2: Use prefixes if there are multiples of the same branch (ex. di, tri, tetra, etc.). These prefixes are not used for alphabetical ordering.



Rule 3: If the branch numbers are the same from either end, start from the end closest to the largest branch.
